

Antioch College Academic Standing Policy

In order to remain in good academic standing, a student must maintain a fall or spring semester GPA of at least a 2.0. A student whose fall or spring semester GPA falls below 2.0 will be placed on academic warning. A student whose fall or spring semester GPA falls below 2.0 for the second consecutive semester will be placed on academic probation. If the student's fall or spring semester GPA falls below 2.0 for a third consecutive semester and/or the cumulative GPA is below 2.0, the student may be placed on academic dismissal from the school and must wait for one semester before applying for re-admission.

Antioch College staff and faculty take seriously a student's academic success toward the goal of a degree. The college will work with a student placed on an academic warning or probation status to create links among them, faculty advisors, the office of the Dean of Students, and other support programs available at the college. Any student is advised to contact the Academic Dean's office at 757-826-1883, ext 236 to discuss intervention strategies that should assist in meeting academic goals.

Please be aware that students are not eligible for any college-sponsored financial assistance through scholarships, work-study programs, etc. as long as the cumulative GPA falls below 2.5.
